ADMISSION NOTICE

Online admission Form through College website (www.rbckandi.in, www.rbconline.org) is required to fill up for admission in B.A. and B. Com. (Honours and Programme) 1st Semester class for the session 2021-22 in this College. The following schedule, rules and regulations should be followed while doing form fill up.

1. Candidates passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination from recognized Board (as prescribed by University of Kalyani), in the year 2019 or 2020 or 2021 are eligible for taking admission.
2. **Separate application form** is required to be filled up for each of the **Honours Course & Programme Course and Programme Course with Physical Education & Geography**.
3. **Physically Handicapped** Candidates are not eligible to Physical Education course.
4. The reservation of seats for SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, Physically Challenged, Sports category etc. are as per rules /Govt. Order. Other eligibility conditions as prescribed by University of Kalyani are also applicable.
5. **Admission on the basis of merit will take place through online as per intake capacity. Date of online admission for 1st Phase, 2nd Phase & 3rd Phase etc. will be given on website from time to time until the seats are fulfilled.**
6. After admission, all relevant certificates (Admit Card or Certificate of Madhyamik or equivalent Examination, Marksheet of H. S. or equivalent Examination, School Leaving Certificate, Certificate of Caste, Certificate of Physical Handicapped, Certificate of Sports issued by appropriate authority etc.) both in original and photocopy & one copy printed application form must be produced to the College before the documents verification within the schedule time notified by the College authority.
7. If any document is found to be false or incorrect his/her admission **is liable to be rejected**.
8. **Fees once paid will not be refunded at any cost.**
9. As per Kalyani University rules, a student can take admission to the College till three (3) years after passing the H.S. examination. In that case, 2% marks from the obtained total marks of the candidate will be deducted as per rules.
10. The candidates are required to fill up the Application Form duly with the reference to their valid Mobile Ph. No. (preferably WhatsApp no.) and e-mail ID. Candidate will be updated about classes and others official activities of College via provided contact details.
11. College Authority will not be responsible for any On-line problem regarding admission.

➤ **Eligibility for pursuing Honours Course of Studies (Honours Subjects- Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Geography, History, and B.Com.)**

A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained-

i) A minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (best scored five subjects excluding compulsory Environmental Education/ Environmental Science/ Environmental Studies) and 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

ii) 50% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

iii) 55% marks in aggregate when a candidate has not studied the subject or any related subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other conditions are satisfied.

****Relaxation:** However, candidates belonging to the Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe Community taking up Honours Course of Study shall enjoy 5% relaxation in marks in (i), (ii) and (iii) above, as the case may be.
